Finish your BA or BS college degree at the National Labor College (NLC) – the labor movement's own institution educating union members and leaders.

Building trades union members who register for and complete a course in an online degree program are eligible for the **Union Plus NLC Building Trades President's Award**.

Through **NLC's online format**, you can manage your courseload and learning pace. So, whether you need one more class to get your degree or two years' worth, now is the time to enroll in the NLC's bachelor's degree programs:

- Construction Management
- Business Administration
- Emergency Readiness and Response Management

NLC tuition is highly discounted for union members, and your apprenticeship training counts towards your NLC college degree!

Who's eligible:

Current dues-paying members of building trades unions offering Union Plus programs: BAC, Boilermakers, IBEW, IBT, Insulators, Ironworkers, IUEC, IUPAT, LIUNA, OPCMIA, Roofers, SMWIA, and UA. Recipients agree to provide feedback on the degree programs.

Scholarship amounts:

17 scholarships of \$795 each are available. Each scholarship covers a 3-credit course.

How to apply:

Awards are administered by the NLC. Ask about the scholarship when you register at the NLC.

When to apply:

Scholarships are available starting with the January 2012 semester. Deadline to complete your application for the January 2012 semester is December 12, 2011. Check with NLC for deadlines for other semesters.
